



Indicative numbers of clinics for Chemical Pathology training

Chemical Pathology curriculum 2021

Please find below the indicative clinic numbers for trainees following the 2021 Chemical Pathology curriculum as approved by the Chemical Pathology College Specialty Training Committee. These are based on the guidance for the Metabolic Medicine subspecialty curriculum. It is expected that trainees who wish to develop a special interest in any of these areas will want to far exceed these numbers.

NUTRITION	Expected minimum 6 patients seen per clinic/round
Obesity Clinics (ideally with bariatric surgery)	10
Nutrition support ward rounds (TPN)	25
INBORN ERRORS OF METABOLISM	Expected minimum 4 patients seen per clinic
Three-month attachment to Tertiary Paediatric Laboratory	
Paediatric IEM } Adult IEM } PKU Clinics }	25



LIPIDS/CVR	Expected minimum 6 patients see per clinic
Lipid Clinic	40
Hypertension Clinic or Formally combined CVR factor clinics	10 50
BONE/CALCIUM	Expected minimum 6 patients seen per clinic
Metabolic Bone Clinics or Osteoporosis	40 25-30 40 combined
Endocrine/other bone disorder clinics	10-15 clinics
DIABETES CLINICS	Expected 6 patients seen per clinic
Diabetes clinic with Type 1 and 2 diabetes	40

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
