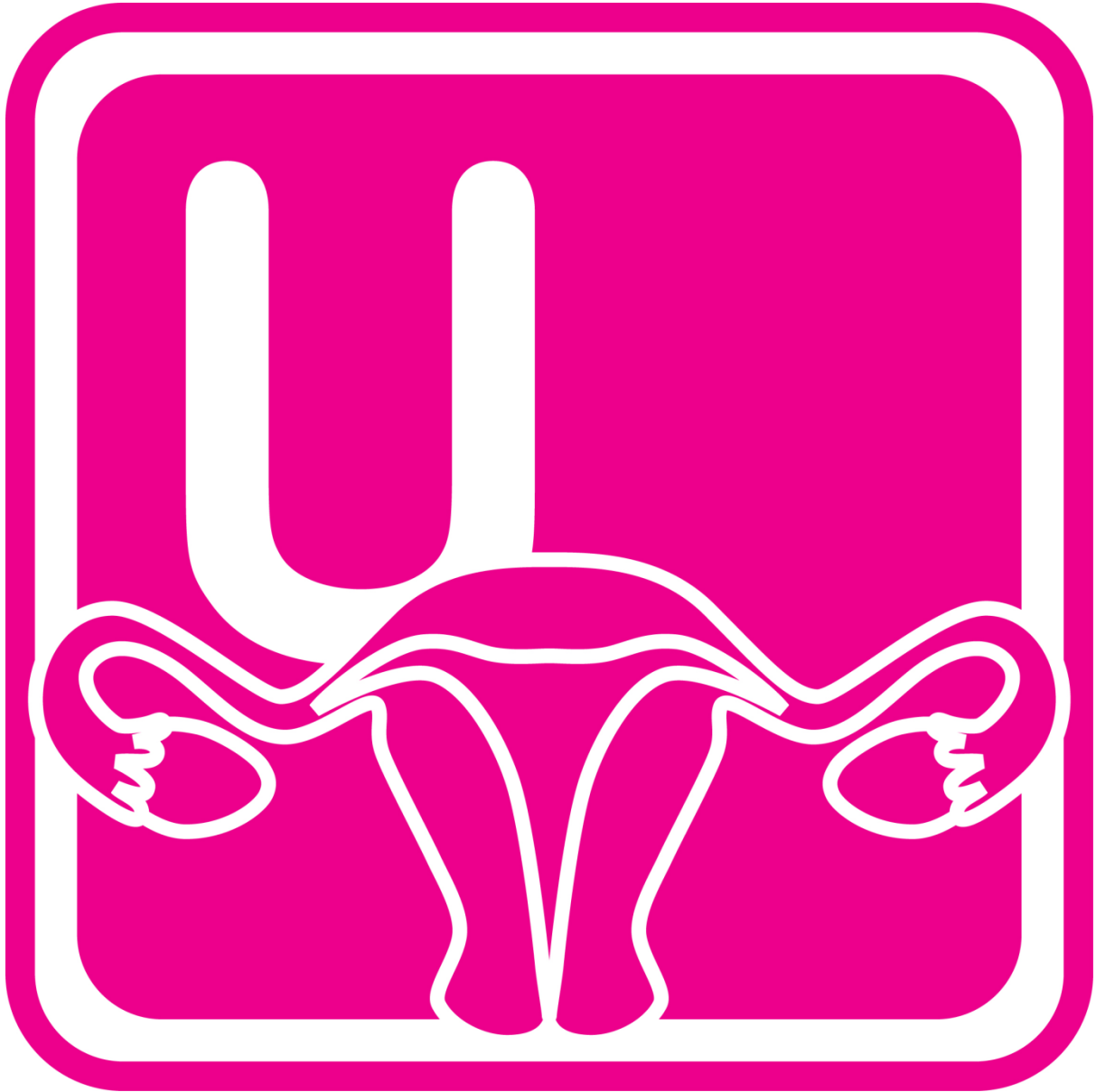

Uterus

The uterus is another name for the womb, the part of the female reproductive tract where babies grow. Disorders of the uterus can cause pain or heavy bleeding.

Histopathologists diagnose uterine diseases such as fibroids or tumours from small biopsies. They also examine the whole uterus following a hysterectomy operation.
