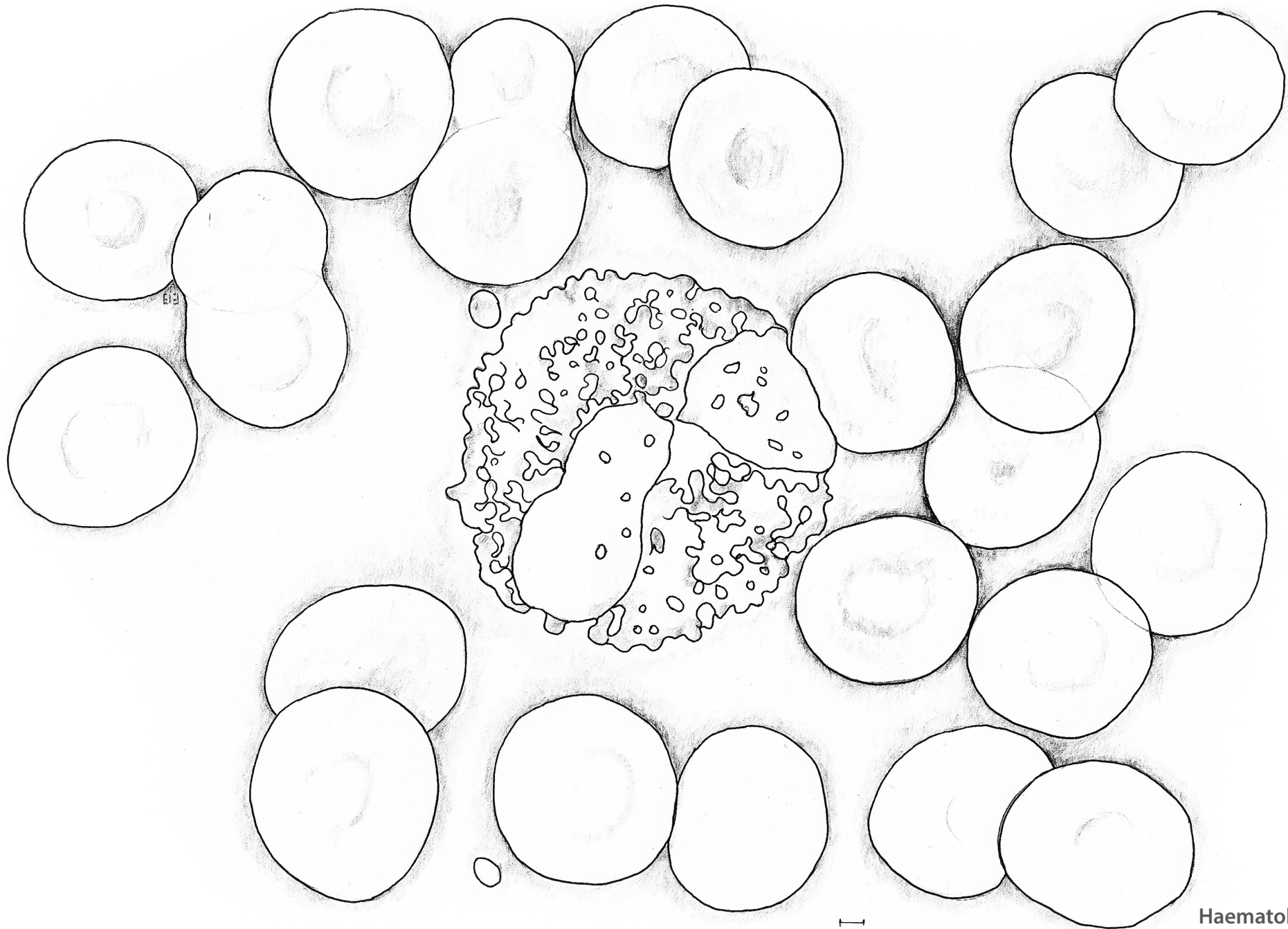


Giver of life

Add colour to reveal the beauty of cells that look after you.

Red blood cells are the regular round structures that carry oxygen. The large irregular object in the middle is a white blood cell (eosinophil), help protect protects us from disease. The smallest shapes are platelets, which can trigger a clot when needed. Add reds to the round cells and use purples or whichever colours you like for the white blood cell and platelets.

The bar at the bottom represents one micrometre (one thousandth of a millimetre). Around 12 red blood cells would fit across the width of a human hair.
